4. electricity produced by water HYDROELECTRICITY
5. part of a sea or lake that cuts into a coastline BAY
6. liquid that circulates through a plant carrying water and food SAP
7. tower with bright lights that shine out over the water to guide ships LIGHTHOUSE
8. place where stone is dug, cut, or blasted out for use in building QUARRY
9. materials that were never alive and are found in the earth MINERAL
10. place where grapevines are planted VINEYARD
11. power that is produced by capturing the energy of flowing water HYDROPOWER
12. a large wire cage with several sections CRAB POT
13. area of soft, wet, spongy ground BOG
14. deep, narrow valley, usually with a stream or river GORGE
